




CPMR activities

+ Climate, Macro-regional and Sea-basin strategies, Migration, Neighborhood, External cooperation...






Global Action Plan and Working Groups 2014-16

GT Water & Energy – Action plan 2014-2016

General Objective: contribute to the sustainable development of the Med provinding concrete responses to strategic challenges in the areas of Water & Energy and to the implementation of most relevant directives/policies

3 Pillars:

- 1. To respond to the strategic challenge on water in the Mediterranean
- 2. To adapt to energy challenges and to promote the potential of renewable energies and energy efficiency in the Med basin
- 3. W&E as transversal elements: synergies on actions that involve a joint approach

Tipology of outputs: political positions, exchnge of experiences, projects, etc

ENI CBC MED 2014-2020 – Water related opportunities

Important elements to keep in mind for future projects:

- 1. Efficient management of water ressources
- 2. Re-use of grey waters
- 3. Policy impact of actions : water management plans etc.
- 4. Base line importance of indicators for future projects

ENI CBC MED 2014-2020 – Forthcoming calls

Hypotetic type of actions (not exhaustive) for the 1st call for standard projects (expected for the end of 2016 or beginning 2017)

- Networking & exchange of best practices among different type of authorities and stakeholders
- Study/Analysis
- Pilots, including innovative elements and potential for replication
- Joint management plans...

Elements to take into account for future strategic project call

- 1. Wider partnerships, duration and funding
- 2. Transversality of the actions to several themes and replicability
- 3. Attention to best practices concerning public policies and decision makers
